## The Tango Society of Boston—Pablo Veron (cont'd)

#### More on Pablo Veron and Noel Strazza

<u>Pablo Veron</u> is probably the most famous, and widely acknowledged as probably the most talented, of his generation of Tango dancers. He was the principal star and choreographer of the movie <u>The Tango Lesson</u>, which is the best-known Tango movie in recent years. He won the <u>American Choreography Award</u> in 1998 and danced at the <u>White House for the Clintons</u> in 1999. He was guest artist and star of <u>Broadway's Tango</u> <u>Argentino at the Gershwin Theatre</u>, and has danced in innumerable other exhibitions and dance companies, including <u>Les Folies Bergere</u> in Paris.

**Noel Strazza** has been dancing as Pablo Veron's partner since last August giving workshops and exhibitions in Europe, the U.S. and Canada, including at the **Värmland Classic Festival** in Sweden. She has studied at the **National School of Dances** and the **Contemporary Dance School of Teatro San Martin**. In 1998 she won the special award as dancer and choreographer at the 5<sup>th</sup> Festival of Amazonas in Brazil.

#### Suggested Combinations

If you are	You should take
<u>Brand new</u> to Tango.	Take the Fundamentals: <b>T1</b> and <b>T2</b> . If you feel comfortable with these, consider adding additional workshops on Saturday.
Advanced Beginner: Have done some Tango before and can dance Tango comfortably around the room.	Take all Saturday's workshops: <b>T1-T4</b> plus <b>V1</b> . Do not skip any of the early workshops!!
Intermediate dancer: Can dance giros comfortably and incorporate them naturally into your dancing.	Take all Saturday workshops and intermediate ( <b>T5-T6</b> and <b>V2</b> ) on Sunday. (The Saturday classes are very important even for experienced dancers.)
Advanced dancer: Can do giros comfortably in both directions and also know boleos, sacadas and ganchos.	Take all weekend workshops. The most advanced dancers should also take Monday's <b>A3-A4</b> .

<u>Prices, Discounts, Registration</u>: Registering in advance gets you the lowest prices—as little as <u>\$13 per hour</u> <u>of instruction</u> (for members in advance taking multiple workshops). The best value for advanced dancers is the <u>Weekend Pass</u>. Students get an additional 30% discount on top of this. See the attached registration form for full details and <u>à la carte</u> rates.
